The campsite is at your disposal from 16.00 on the day of arrival until 16.00 on the day of departure. Maximum load per power outlet is 3,600W. Overloading will cause the fuse to blow.

Remember that the key cards are required to use the showers and drying rooms. Please note that we are not responsible for personal belongings stored in the drying room.

TV, digital signals.

There is a washing machine and dryer available in the lower sanitary building. Use of these costs NOK 20 per use.

Fire protection instructions

We hope you will take the time to familiarise yourself with these instructions and thereby contribute to a safe and pleasant campsite in Trysilfjellet.

- Due to the risk of contamination in the event of a fire, no part of the camping unit (caravan, tent, etc.) **must be placed closer to a neighbour than 4 metres.**
- Cars without overnight parking can be parked in this free zone.
- In the event of a fire, anyone who may be at risk must be notified immediately, the fire service must be called and extinguishing must be implemented with the available equipment.
- Rescue of at-risk equipment is carried out by removing cars, caravans, dismantling empty tents, etc.
- The fire extinguisher is located outside on the wall of the building. It hangs on the north-facing wall towards the main road. Fire extinguishers can also be found on some of the lampposts in the area.
- The name and address of the campsite is:

- Never light a fire without special permission from the campsite manager (mobile 900 13 230).
- Cooking on an open fire, e.g barbecuing, must take place outside. Open flames must never come closer to unprotected materials than 60 cm.
- In the event of propane leaks that cannot be located and shut off immediately, contact the manager straightaway (mobile 900 13 230).
- All open flames, including anything that is smoking, must be extinguished immediately to avoid the gas igniting.
- Flammable and combustible waste such as empty lighter fluid containers, charcoal, paper and the like must be placed in the wrought iron cans at the sanitary facilities.
- We encourage everyone to show care and caution when storing and treating barbecue lighter fluid, propane gas, etc.
